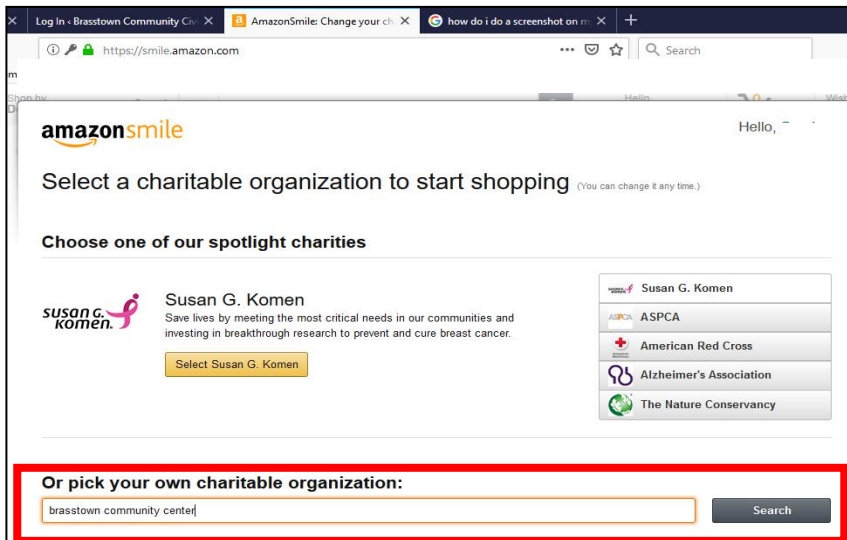


## WAYS TO HELP BCCC

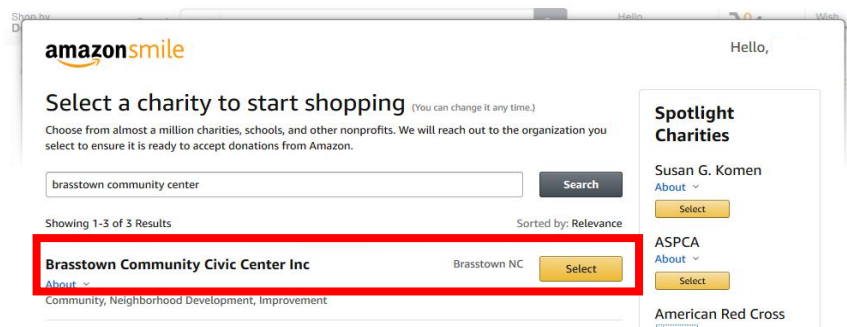

Here are several ways that you can help support us so we can keep providing a clean and safe facility for the community.

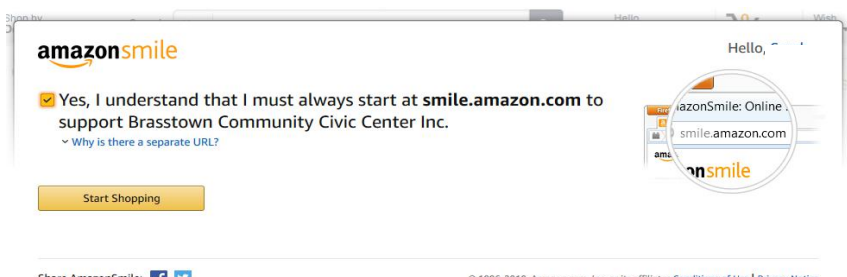
- 1) Come to any of our fundraising events throughout the year. Come to a summer bluegrass concert, take a chance on the quilt raffle, participate in any fundraising event throughout the year.
- 2) Mail a check directly to Brasstown Community Civic Center, PO Box 111, Brasstown, North Carolina 28902.

- 4) Rent the facility for an event - birthday party, wedding reception, baby shower, family reunion, craft fair, yard sale, educational class, etc.

We have several options: a large hall/gymnasium facility with a stage in the corner (tables and chairs are available for any setup), a small community room for cozier meetings or reunions, a separate building known as the “schoolhouse” with a classroom setup that can stay put for more than a day or two.

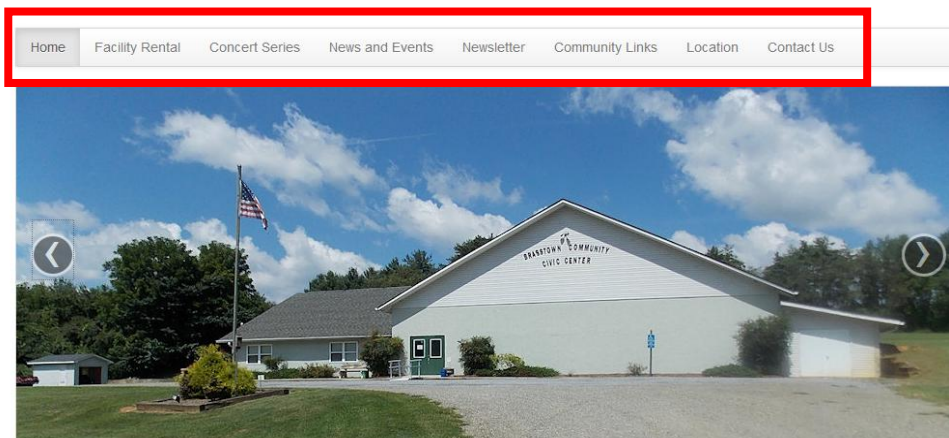
We also have a “Type 1 commercial community kitchen”. This commercial kitchen is available to residents of both Clay and Cherokee counties. We worked with local small farmers and home gardeners to supply a certified commercial kitchen that can be used for their canning and preserving needs in such a way that they may meet the new requirements to sell their product.

The rental fees for the Brasstown Community Center facilities are as follows:

- **Large Hall/Gymnasium (includes kitchen)**
  - \$60/day for Brasstown community residents (28902 zip code)
  - \$80/day for non-Brasstown residents
- **Classroom/Schoolhouse**
  - \$25/day for classes
  - \$35/day for other events (baby shower, etc)
- **Kitchen Only**
  - \$5/Hour (min. of 4 hours)
  - Free personal canning for Brasstown community residents
- **Cleaning deposit**
  - \$50 deposit required on all rentals
  - Check due at time of rental
  - Event is added to our calendar when the deposit is received
