The Brasstown Community Center is a 501C3 charitable organization. All proceeds from donations and fundraisers go towards the Community Center for upkeep, maintenance and improvements to the facility.

Here are several ways that you can help support us so we can keep providing a clean and safe facility for the community.

- Come to any of our fundraising events throughout the year. Come to a summer bluegrass concert, take a chance on the quilt raffle, participate in any fundraising event throughout the year.

- 3) Rent the facility for an event birthday party, wedding reception, baby shower, family reunion, craft fair, yard sale, educational class, etc.

We have several options: a large hall/gymnasium facility with a stage in the corner (tables and chairs are available for any setup), a small community room for cozier meetings or reunions, a separate building known as the "schoolhouse" with a classroom setup that can stay put for more than a day or two.

We also have a "Type 1 commercial community kitchen". This commercial kitchen is available to residents of both Clay and Cherokee counties. We worked with local small farmers and home gardeners to supply a certified commercial kitchen that can be used for their canning and preserving needs in such a way that they may meet the new requirements to sell their product.

The rental fees for the Brasstown Community Center facilities are as follows:

- Large Hall/Gymnasium (inckudes kitchen)
 - \$80/day
- Classroom/Schoolhouse
 - \$35/day
- Kitchen Only
 - \$5/Hour (min. of 4 hours)
 - o Free personal canning for Brasstown community residents
- Reservation/Cleaning deposit
 - \$50 deposit required on all rentals
 - Fees are due at time of rental
 Event is scheduled when fees are received
 - Cancellations must be made 7 days prior to event date if not, your deposit will be forfeited.
